

## **Camp Rules**

## **National Jamboree 2024**

- 1. The Scout Law and the Youth Law are the laws of the Jamboree.
- 2. Participants must remain on the Jamboree grounds for the duration of the Jamboree, excepting external activities sponsored by the Jamboree committee. In other cases, a permit is required from the Jamboree committee to leave the premises.
- 3. Participants must return to their camps after the end of the evening program. Quiet time will start after the end of the planned program and no later than 23:00. Please respect that some scouts may be sleeping at this time.
- 4. Smoking and the use of nicotine are strictly prohibited on the Jamboree grounds. This includes the use of vape, e-cigarettes, nicotine pouches, and chewing tobacco.
- 5. The use of alcohol or other stimulants is prohibited during the Jamboree. Any violation of this will result in expulsion without exception.
- 6. Participants are encouraged to wear their scout/guide uniforms, especially at major events like the opening and closing ceremonies. At other times you should always, at a minimum, wear the Jamboree neckerchief.
- 7. Fires may not be lit except in designated areas.
- 8. Motorized traffic is prohibited on the Jamboree grounds, except as authorized by the Jamboree committee.
- 9. Drones are not allowed at the campsite.
- 10. Participants must abide by the camp rules for the duration of the Jamboree.
- 11. Contingent leaders are responsible for their scouts/guides abiding by these rules.
